You are scheduled for a colonoscopy, a procedure in which a doctor examines the lining of your large intestine by looking through a flexible tube called a colonoscope. If growths or other abnormalities are found during the procedure, the doctor may remove the abnormal tissue for biopsy.

<ol> <li>Adhere to a clear liquid diet all day-remember to stay hydrated and drink plenty of fluids.</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Take Dulcolax (2 tablets) at: <u>2hrs before</u> <u>HydroPrep</u></li> <li>Stop all oral intake 1 hour before your arrival</li> </ol>
<ul> <li><u>Clear Liquids</u>:</li> <li>Clear broth, bouillon, apple or white grape juice, popsicles, Jell-O, Gatorade, lemonade, tea, coffee (non-dairy creamer). No purple, red, or orange colors. Nothing solid of any kind.</li> <li>2. Medication Instructions:</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>time at ColoCleanse Center (except as indicated below)</li> <li>You may take your essential morning medications (heart, blood pressure or anti-seizure medication) with 2 oz (4 tablespoons) of water 2-4 hours prior to your arrival time at ColoCleanse, unless otherwise directed by your physician.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Dulcolax 5 mg stimulant laxative</li> <li>➢ Dulcolax (2 tablets) 10 AM</li> <li>➢ Dulcolax (2 tablets) 1 PM</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>After your prep is completed, proceed directly to the endoscopy center or hospital. Bring the following to the Endoscopy Center or Hospital:</li> <li>Responsible adult driver to stay with you, and drive you home. Your procedure will not start without your driver present!</li> <li>Insurance Cards</li> <li>Photo ID</li> </ul>
